NON-CLUB SPONSORED LITERATURE POLICY

Last updated: March 13, 2023

During club meetings and events, the following guidelines will be used regarding literature not officially distributed by the club:

1. Campaign material for Democratic candidates (or Democratic-identifying candidates in non-partisan races) may be distributed at club events and meetings. Any material not kept by club members and guests must be taken back up by the campaign/candidate at the end of the event or it will be disposed.
2. Literature from club members, such as newsletters, event flyers, etc., may be distributed with the consent of a member of the executive board. All material not kept by club members and guests must be taken back up by the distributor at the end of the event or it will be disposed.
3. Literature from non-club members may be distributed with the consent of a majority of all executive board members present. All material not kept by club members and guests must be taken back up by the distributor at the end of the event or it will be disposed.
4. Any literature promoting any party other than the Democratic Party, including slate cards with a mixture of Democratic and Republican candidates, is prohibited. Failure to follow this policy may result in your expulsion from the event and a ban from attending future events.
5. Any literature promoting racist, sexist, homophobic, or any other forms of bigotry is prohibited. Failure to follow this policy may result in your expulsion from the event and a ban from attending future events.
6. Approved literature may only be left in the chairs at the event by the event sponsor. All other material must either be handed out personally or left at the designated location for literature.
